

Say My Name Game

This game is intended for Cub Scouts and is best played before a Pack meeting as the scouts start to arrive as they can join in the game at any time. It is a good "ice breaker" type game that helps scouts learn the names of other scouts not in their dens and the names of any visiting boys, such as at a Roundup night.

Location: This game can be played inside or outside.

Notes: Helps improve memory skills.

Equipment: One (1) small, soft, "nerf" style ball

Instructions:

1. All scouts stand in a circle.
2. One scout begins by saying the name of any other scout and tossing the ball to that scout.
3. The scout catching the ball then says the name of a different scout and tosses the ball to him.
4. As scouts or visitors arrive they can join in at any time, saying their name as they join
5. the circle.
6. The pace can be increase as scouts learn each others names.
